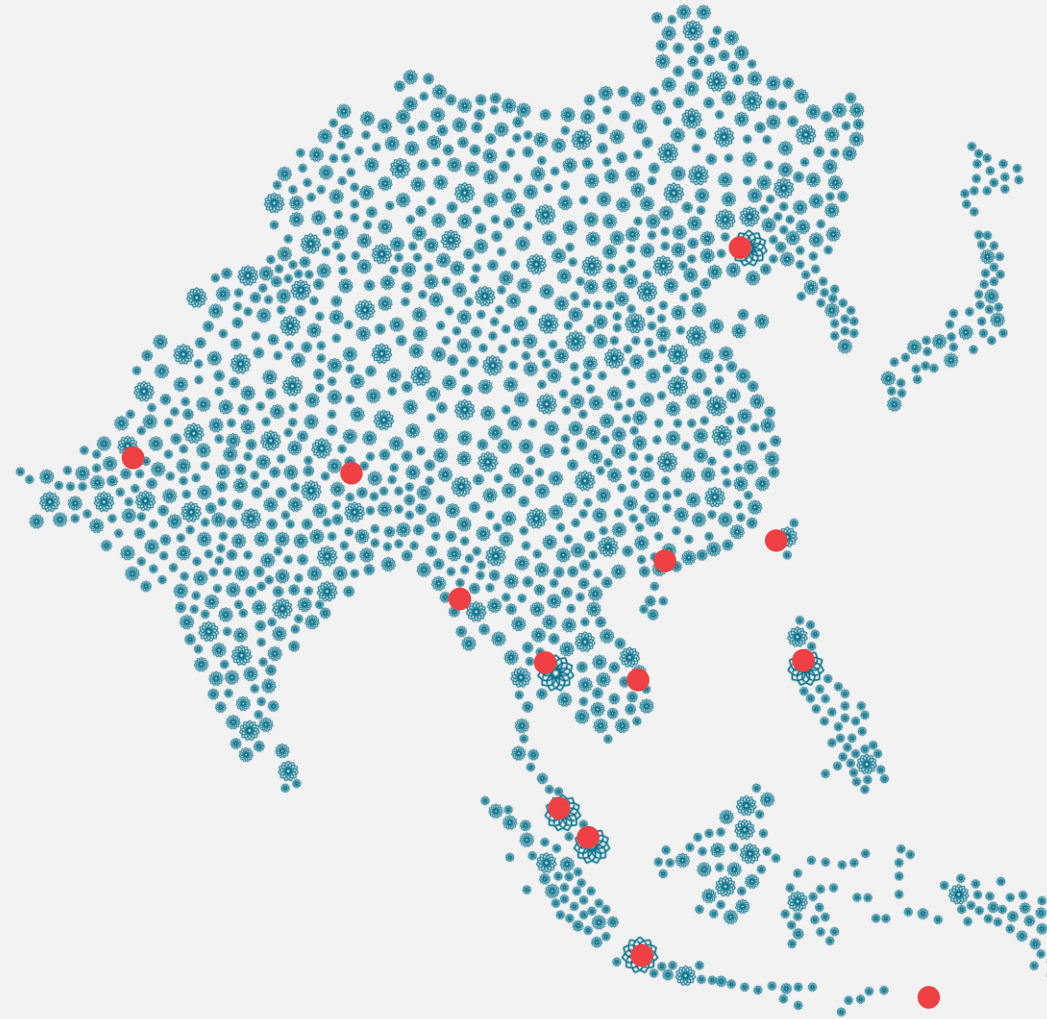

Covid-19 Situation in Vietnam

- Vietnam has experienced a surge in COVID-19 cases since April 2021, despite having successfully contained the pandemic last year.
- As of 31st August 2021, **449,489 cases** of COVID-19 have been confirmed. **11,064 deaths** recorded.
- Ho Chi Minh city began strict social distancing measures under **Directive 11 from August 23**.
- 6 southern provinces extended social distancing measures until mid-September.
- Currently only **2.4% of the population is fully vaccinated**. 17.4% has received first dose.

SHARING RESTAURANT

The "Sharing Restaurant" model was born and deployed from taking advantage of locations at restaurants that have not yet served customers in the morning; mobilize clean food sources from sponsors and cook free meals. This activity will maintain regularly at noon every Saturday and the number of meals will gradually increase according to the needs of the people.



THE LOVE KITCHEN

The Love Kitchen operates as a sub-model of Food Bank Vietnam with the task of cooking and supporting meals and food to the needy and the front lines against the epidemic (2000 meals/day).



COMMUNITY REFRISHGERATOR

The model "Community refrigerator" is used for the purpose of transferring food between people who have surplus and people who lack food. The surplus will come and put the food in the cupboard for the needy to come and pick it up. In addition to the community meaning, this model also has the meaning of fighting food waste.



MOBILE RICE CREW

Model "Mobile rice cart" to limit the gathering of people at a rice distribution point. These portable rice bowls are effective in distributing rice to many people while also being safe in the prevention and control of COVID-19.

OUR ACTIVITIES



FARM TO FOOD BANK

The campaign to support farmers to consume agricultural products is part of the Smile Farmers series of Food Bank Vietnam with the Farm to Food Bank model of purchasing agricultural products from farmers at reasonable prices and delivering them to consumers. at a good price, the rest will be donated to open house shelters



SUPPORT FOOD FOR FRONTLINE WORKER

The front-line relay campaign will provide timely information about the donation, support and frontline support food activities of organizations and individuals at home and abroad, etc. Thereby, contributing to raising awareness. sharing, solidarity, responsibility to protect public health for all classes of people.



COMMUNITY HOTEL

The "Community Hotel" model was born, contributing a part of our efforts to the fight against the epidemic, providing free accommodation and meals for frontline doctors and nurses in the fight against the epidemic. At the community hotel, Food Bank Vietnam also supports free meals



FIELD CONTAINER

The field container helps the functional forces at the checkpoints to have a rest space, contributing to ensuring the health and working conditions for the frontline forces in epidemic prevention. Food Bank Vietnam supports daily necessities and food at these locations

Strategic partnership for education (in Vietnam)



Education is an existing area of interest for many philanthropists

- Education is the top cause for philanthropic support in Asia
- Almost 30% of respondents in a 2017 LIN Centre study with its donors chose (access to) education as the top 'future giving priority'
- Leverage on common interest for collaboration

Academic institutions are catalysts for transformative change

- Philanthropic funding to universities during the Covid-19 helped facilitate research and vaccine development
 - Estimated 22% of research funding for Oxford/AstraZeneca vaccine from charitable foundations
 - Asian philanthropists funding major universities in China, Japan and Singapore to do vaccine research
